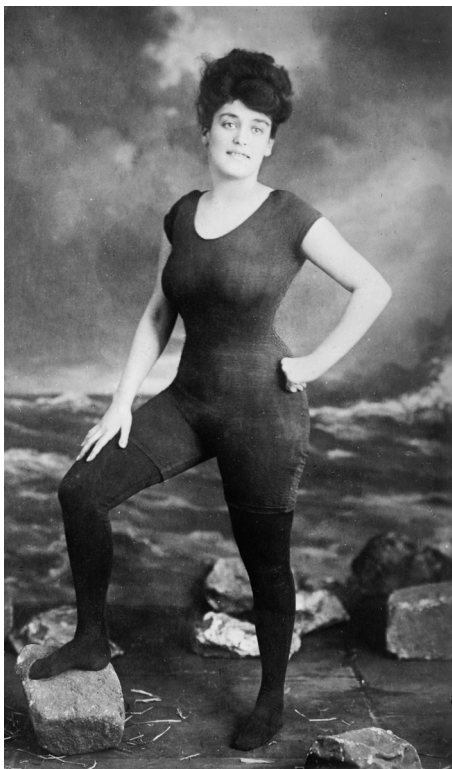

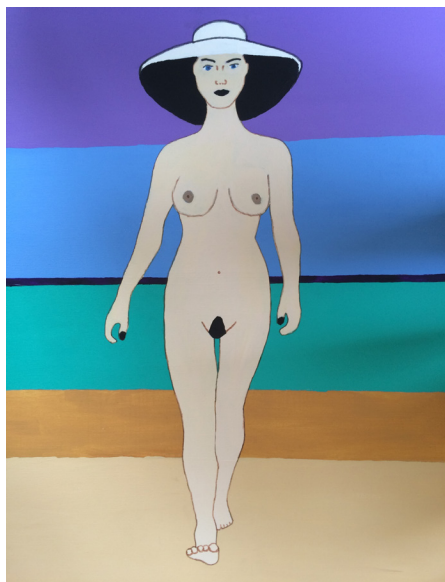
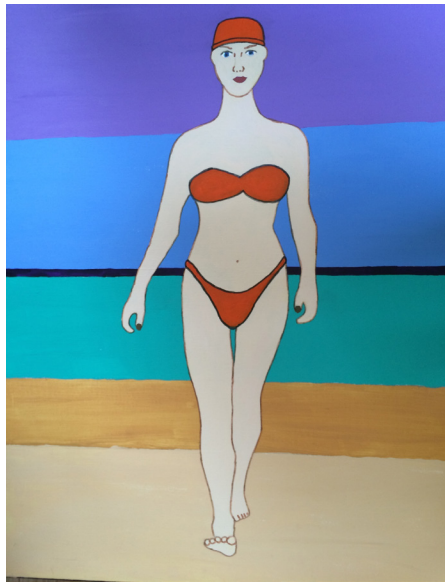


Dedikasjon - Annette Kellerman (6. juli 1886 - 6. november 1975) var en australsk profesjonell svømmer, film skuespiller og forfatter. Hun oppfant sporten synkronsvømming. Hun var en av de første kvinnene til å bruke sammenhengende badedrakt. I 1907 ble hun arrestert på Revere Beach, Massachusetts, for uanstendighet, i drakten lik den til venstre.

Dedication - Annette Kellerman (July 6th, 1886 – November 6th, 1975) was an Australian professional swimmer, film actress and writer. She invented the sport of synchronized swimming. She was one of the first women to wear a one-piece bathing suit. In 1907, she was arrested on Revere Beach, Massachusetts, for indecency, in the bathing suit like the one shown on the left.

Malerlærling Billi Sodds utstilling tar for seg hvordan vår følelse av anstendighet (beskjedenhet) har endret seg med tiden. De åtte malerier viser badedrakter som brukes av sju generasjoner av kvinner, som representerer 1910, 1930, 1950, 1970, 1990 og 2010. I tillegg er det to forslag, som viser hvordan badedrakter kan muligens se ut i 2030: 2030 Maxi og 2030 Mini.

Apprentice painter Billi Sodd's exhibition looks at how our sense of modesty has changed with time. The eight paintings show bathing suits used by seven generations of women, representing 1910, 1930, 1950, 1970, 1990 and 2010. In addition there are two suggestions, showing what bathing suits might look like in 2030: 2030 Maxi and 2030 Mini.
